### 10 CSR 20-6.030 Stakeholder Status Update Meeting

#### Revision to 10 CSR 20-6.030 regarding the method of wastewater treatment in a residential housing (subdivision) development.

The Water Protection Program is hosting a stakeholder meeting to provide a process status update to revisions of 10 CSR 20-6.030 on July 19, 2023, from 2:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. The meeting will be held in person at the Lewis and Clark State Office Building at 1101 Riverside Drive, Jefferson City, MO 65102 and virtually via WebEx. The current regulation sets forth the minimum standards when determining the method of wastewater treatment within a residential housing (subdivision) development that propose the use of individual onsite wastewater treatment (septic) systems on individual lots. As discussed in the August 2022 stakeholder meetings, the Missouri Department of Natural Resources is considering adding a provision for an alternative determination to assist individual lot owners with compliance of the rule. The Department of Natural Resources is also proposing the deletion of Multiple Family Housing Units section, as that can be satisfied by meeting an existing exemption as contained in 10 CSR 20-6.030(1)(C) 6. With the exception of administrative edits such as nomenclature, verbiage, and ensuring that the definitions contained within 10 CSR 20-6.030(1)(A) definitions mirror those in 10 CSR 20-2.010 definitions, the amendments shall be limited to the addition of an Alternative Determination section and the deletion of the Multiple Family Housing Unit section. All other sections within the rule including the methodology for approval will remain the same.
