#### President's Message



Dear Landowners,

Happy Spring! Forbes is looking beautiful this time of year as the dogwoods bloom and the forest leaves begin to fill in. As president, I have been extremely proud of all of the hard work our employees, committees and volunteers have been doing this past year to make sure everything at Forbes runs smoothly, is in excellent repair and offers a wide variety of activities and community outreach for people of all ages and I offer my sincerest thanks to each and every one of you to making Forbes such a wonderful place to call my home.

Over the past two years, Forbes maintenance department has taken on the challenge of taking over as many areas of the maintenance of the park as possible rather than using subcontractors. In order to do this Forbes has needed to purchase more of its own equipment. This fall, we purchased a 2021 John Deere 310SL HL Backhoe Loader. This will allow us to clear and dig ditches, clean culverts, clear away debris and trees, as well as a variety of other applications. In the past, Forbes was spending, on average, \$70,000 per year to subcontract backhoe work for the park. We also purchased a Buffalo PTO Blower. This is an industrial blower that can blow the leaves out of the ditches to help keep the ditches and culverts clear. Clear ditches will keep runoff water flowing through the ditches and help prevent washouts from occurring on the roadways.

We were happy to welcome back our Forbes Fishing Tournament 2024 last year. The fishing tournament was held at the Deer Creek Arm of Lake of the Ozark. Several of our Forbes families came out, caught some fish and shared in a wonderful picnic lunch. This year the Fishing Tournament will be held on Saturday June 7th. Please watch for further announcements from our events committee. At this point in time the Bob Lake Dam repair is still in litigation but we do hope to have some resolution to that matter soon and will give updates as we know them.

As always, as a forest community, Forbes is highly vigilant for any signs of forest fire or other extreme weather event. In order to keep our more local community alert to such dangers Forbes started a One Call Now system. **One Call Now** is a broadcast messaging service that Forbes will use to quickly send messages to Forbes landowners to alert them to Forest Fires, Tornado Warnings, Severe Thunderstorm Warnings, or any other emergency that may arise affecting landowners on their lots. In order to be proactive and to help reduce the amount of ground debris, Forbes is starting a once a month 3" or smaller limb and stick drop off at a designated area to the right of the maintenance shed behind the Forbes Office. The date and time will be announced each month. The maintenance staff will then shred the limbs and free mulch will be available for pickup anytime during daylight hours.

I hope all of our landowners are able to visit their lot(s) this year and see how beautiful Forbes Lake of the Ozarks Park, LOA is in person! My door is always open, and it is my honor to serve as this year's president.

#### Lakes & Wildlife

All lakes are thriving with minnows, and weed control is showing positive results. New fish structures have been installed, and both turkey and deer populations are excellent, a couple of Bobcat have also been seen.

Dredging on Bob Lake is complete.

Eggs have been found in the duck house on Turtle Pond, and cameras will soon be installed at all duck houses—please keep a safe distance.

We plan to introduce hydroponic plants to the lakes and ask landowners to retain any bass 12 inches and under to improve fishing quality.

Additionally, a "Bragging Rights" bulletin board has been set up at the office to showcase impressive catches from Forbes Lakes. Feel free to email or bring in a photo of your catch to the office for display.

We also encourage everyone to fill out fishing reports to help track improvements and enhance community engagement.


